Trash Management:




Once again there is a problem with trash placed beside the dumpster! We avoided a big clean-up expense thanks to responsible owners who managed the problem. A big thank you to those owners! Had the dumpster been placed on top of the trash Rothmoor may have had big expense dealing with the clean-up. The trash is emptied on Tuesday and Friday, barring holiday exceptions. If the dumpster if full, please take your trash back home. Note: the dumpsters are probably full late Monday and Thursday evenings. Maybe take your trash after pick-up on Tuesday or Friday. This Christmas holiday, some owners sent their guests home with presents and bags of trash! How creative!

Recycling Trash: To reduce the amount of trash going into the dumpster please recycle. The recycle center is 5 minutes away.

One Call: Currently the management company is the only party able to send out one call alerts. The Board will get with Corey, get the password and the procedure for sending alerts. This will allow Board Members to send alerts in addition to Corey, as needed.

Neighborhood Watch: There have been more events of young kids coming into community from the park doing mischief. The Board will be discussing options to limit access.

Reminder Rules & Regs Parking on Premises



Park as close to the curb as possible but not on the grass.



Don't park on the grass.



Don't partially or fully block any driveway.



Don't park across the end of any driveway.



Do not block the ends of the driveways or block sidewalks.



Don't park directly across from another car or directly across from someone's driveway.



One car per driveway and do not block sidewalk.



Visitor parking is reserved for visitors. No overnight resident parking allowed.

ON a serious matter: New Board members reviewed items in the office. There is a cabinet filled with keys labelled for many villas. It is not known if these keys are current allowing access into the properties for emergency reasons. The Board is working on a process to confirm the status of the keys. The Neighborhood Watch Committee would be to establish a process to report activity happening in the community so owners can be informed in a timely manner. It would be great if people with cameras would consider this committee.

The Clubhouse Committee would be a committee to evaluate status of the clubhouse, identify what needs to be addressed, suggest priority of items, and evaluate cost for corrective action.

The Beautification Committee would help coordinate landscaping issues, monitor landscape issues in the community, and assist with coordination of activities associated with replanting (if Rothmoor is awarded \$3000 in City money).

All committees would report to the President of the Board. The Board will then address these recommendations.

January is the coldest month in the Northern Hemisphere and the warmest in the Southern Hemisphere.


