# What's Happening in the Community

#### Beautification Committee:

The committee walked the property, identified areas in most need of attention, and contracted with the Landscaping Company to remove dead plants and replant these areas. The committee defined the selection of plants owners could choose for replanting. These plants were selected for being drought resistant and Florida friendly which should help reduce the maintenance costs and hopefully water usage once the plants are established. The Committee has taken direction from The Pinellas

County Agricultural Extension Agency Florida
Friendly Landscaping Experts. A special thank you
to Karen, Rick, and Bob who worked on fixing
sprinkler systems throughout the property.
Additionally, Rothmoor has successfully applied for
and was awarded \$3000 towards our mission of
which we had to match. Thank you, Karen, for your
work getting this award! The 1<sup>st</sup> phase of dead
plant removal and replanting was completed. We
can re-apply for the award money next year and
continue with our progress.

# Pool:



Reminder to all: if you use an umbrella in the pool area be sure to close and tie it down before you leave as the wind can blow it open and damage both the table and umbrella.

If you notice the water level is low in the pool, please use the hose and add water. Remember to turn off water and replace the hose before leaving.

### Street Lights:

There are security lights out on the property which have been tagged with yellow tape. Repair requires digging underground to determine the cause. The sewer and electric lines have been marked with pink flags so they will not be disturbed when the company digs into the ground. There is no expense to Rothmoor for this repair.



### Garbage:

The city picks up trash on Tuesday and Friday. Cardboard boxes: Please breakdown before placing them in the dumpster. Better yet consider recycling them.

Bulk Item Removal: Bulk waste removal is the responsibility of the resident and should <u>not</u> be placed in or around the dumpster. There are several local companies that provide this service. (Some company names posted on last page)

<u>Largo Leader Newspaper</u>: Sometimes the Largo Newspaper gets delivered to everyone. You may not notice it if you just hop in your car and head out. They are laying in the yards and driveways for several days. If you notice it, please pick it up. Several residents have been picking them up and recycling them.
